Race Number

Race numbers will be available to collect from 8:30am from Wix Village Hall.

Your timing chip is stuck to the back of your race number. Your race number must NOT be folded or mutilated in any way. Your race number should be pinned to the front of your vest/t-shirt. Your number must be visible when crossing the finish line. Please, when stopping your watch keep your arms clear of your number to help with reading your timing chip. Please don't return to the finish line once you have finished, this could result in the timing chip being read for a second time and giving you a slower finish time.

Please aim to arrive at the Race HQ at least 90 minutes before the start to allow plenty of time for race number collection and pre-race briefing.

Medical Information

You must write your details on the reverse of your race number, including your emergency contact number. If you have a medical condition, please specify full details on the back of the race number and put a cross on the top right corner of your number on the front.

It is a short walk to Race HQ from the Equestrian centre.

Runners are encouraged to car share to reduce the environmental impact of the race.
